Presente simple verbo to be (ser o estar)

I am (I'm)	I'm not	Am I?
You are (You're)	You aren't	Are you?
He/She/It is (He's/ she's/ It's)	He/she/it isn't	Is he/she/it?
We are (We're)	We aren't	Are we?
You are (You're)	You aren't	Are you?
They are (They're)	They aren't	Are they?

Presente simple verbo to have (haber o tener)

have (I've) got	I haven't got	Have I got?
You have (You've) got	You haven't got	Have you got?
He/She/It has (He's) got	He/She/It hasn't got	Has he/she/it got?
We have (We've) got	We haven't got	Have we got?
You have (You've) got	You haven't got	Have you got?
They have (They've) got	They haven't got	Have they got?

Haber impersonal (presente)

There is	There isn't	Is there?
There are	There aren't	Are there?

Haber impersonal (pasado)

There was	There wasn't	Was there?
There were	There weren't	Were there?
